**-Revision and Official Approval of gtPathways Protocol**

**-Author an official Council resolution, what our policy is concerning courses that are changed, in any way, AFTER they have been reviewed and approved for final placement into the gtPathways curriculum?**

- **How should we configure the two, newly established advisory committees of the GE 25 (1. Faculty; 2. Advisors/Registrars)? How many members do we want on the advisory committees? How should they be chosen? How long should they serve?**
- **How should we configure the Content Review Committees for both the Faculty-to-Faculty Conference and the gtPathways reviews? Who should serve as chairs? Should we have vice-chairs? How long should there terms be? Should we include this in the gtPathways protocol?**

-Should the GE 25 Council author an official resolution concerning the general education curriculum at UCD and the CCCS (that the courses included in the GE are contingent upon their approval for placement in the gtPathways curriculum)?

-Establish GE 25 Council meeting calendar for 2006

**Discussion Items:**

- Core stamp-yes or no?
- Grandfathering for students with changing GT Pathways requirements and programs-for how long?

- Minimum grade for GT Pathways courses that will guarantee transfer (C – is congruent with other transfer policies and stated on our website).
- Can any course have more than one GT Pathways designation?
- General agreement on what "significant writing component" means.
- (Should) the GE 25 Council develop a list of majors at four-year colleges and universities that have specific course requirements for the 60+60 program and list on the CCHE web site. Are any majors in the liberal arts and sciences allowed to exceed 120 hours? (Confirm)
- Consider approving new GT Pathway courses in the early spring, in time to be included in GT course listings in individual, printed college catalogs for the new academic year. (Already aligned with printing deadlines ??)
- Should we beta test the revised forms?
