2. How do we determine eligibility for the lower-division core waiver? Is it based on the date of their enrollment in a four-year institution, the student's date of completion of their AA/AS degree, the start date for their enrollment in an AA/AS degree program, or some combination of these?

Can we use the above two questions to: create an agreed upon matrix to be used in responding to advising questions; update the gtPathways website/FAQs, and to add to the current list of questions we have for the Advisors and Registrars Advisory Group?
