12:45 – 1:15	<p>Finalize Recommendations and PPT Slides –Ian</p> <p><u>Communication –Dean and Alexis send hard copy to Dean and Ian. Advising/Placement/Transfer – Casey send Ian and Dean. Connect meta-majors with programs of studies. Multiple measures be used for placement, including HS GPA, & CCHE remedial policy have math subscores by pathway. Client discipline education: 1) revisit DwD’s and 2) client discipline pick most appropriate competencies and then math department helps choose most appropriate math course based on competencies.</u></p>
