Topic/Issue/Question: How to track students participating in COSLI(CO Student Leaders Institute). Can COSLI participants be tracked by adding a selection option to SURDS course file-High School Concurrent Type, called "4= HS COSLI Participants SB15-290"? If DAG objects then a new column could be added to the SURDS Enrollment file called "COSLI" and only the participating institution would submit.

Notes: COSLI was created in SB15-290. It looks like it does not specify which institution will host the 3-credit hours the students receive as part of this program. See a bill summary at the link here:
