

Colorado Application for State Financial Aid

The Colorado Application for State Financial Aid (CASFA) creates opportunity and access to higher education for undocumented students who do not have lawful immigration status. The CASFA allows Colorado ASSET students to receive state-funded financial aid at postsecondary institutions. Those who do not meet the eligibility criteria below are still encouraged to apply for institutional aid using the CASFA.

To qualify for Colorado ASSET in-state tuition per <u>House Bill 22-</u> <u>1155</u> passed in 2022, an undocumented student must:

- Have attended a public or private high school in Colorado for at least one year immediately before graduation or completed a High School Equivalency (HSE) diploma in Colorado. One year is defined as two academic terms immediately preceding graduation or HSE examination in Colorado.
- Have continuous physical presence in Colorado for
 12 months preceding the start of the semester.
- Apply for and complete an affidavit with the <u>College</u>
 <u>Opportunity Fund</u> (COF) indicating that you have applied for legal presence or will apply as soon as you are eligible to do so.
- Submit official final Colorado high school transcripts indicating one year of attendance at a Colorado high school immediately preceding graduation or submit official HSE transcript, if applicable.

Who is eligible to apply?

CASFA is a safe, easy way to apply for **state financial aid** if you are an undocumented student.

Students who are not eligible for Colorado ASSET can use the CASFA to apply for **institutional aid.**

If you are eligible for federal financial aid, you should complete the <u>Free Application for Federal Student Aid</u> (FASFA).


