Education and Training Voucher (ETV) Program

Summary

The Education and Training Voucher (ETV) program is a federally funded program administered by the Colorado Department of Higher Education. The program provides Colorado residents who are currently or have previously been in foster care and are between the ages of 17 to 25 with financial support for postsecondary education at a college, university, vocational, technical, or trade school.

Eligibility Criteria

- To participate, a student must be a current or former foster student and meet these criteria:
 - Has been accepted into or enrolled in a degree, certificate, or other accredited program at a college, university, technical, or vocational school;
 - To remain eligible for ETV funding, student must show progress toward a certificate of completion, associate, bachelor's, or postgraduate degree;
 - Is between the ages of 17 to 25; and
 - Is a U.S. citizen or qualified non-citizen
- In addition, student must meet one of the following criteria:
 - Was in foster care on or after their 14th birthday; or
 - Had a finalized adoption with adoption assistance on or after their 16th birthday; or
 - Had a guardianship assistance established on or after their 16th birthday; or
 - Was in Division of Youth Services community placement on or after their 14th birthday

Amount of Funding

ETV recipients can receive a maximum amount of \$5,000 per year. The maximum number of years a student can receive ETV funding is 5 years (consecutive or intermittent).

Students must fill out the ETV application, which is located on our website.
