Public Content

In 2008, the state legislature passed the "Colorado Achievement Plan for Kids Act" (CAP4K), aligning Colorado's preschool through postsecondary education system to enable students to graduate ready for success in college and careers. The Act required the Colorado State Board of Education and Colorado Commission of Higher Education to jointly adopt a description of postsecondary and workforce readiness, and to periodically review and update the description. The description was last approved by the board in December 2015. Staff from the Department of Education and the Department of Higher Education have conferred and recommend that the state board and commission affirm the current description, as is: "Colorado high school graduates demonstrate the knowledge and skills (competencies) needed to succeed in postsecondary settings and to advance in career pathways as lifelong learners and contributing citizens."
