#### IV. DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS

1. December 2 CCHE Agenda Item: RECOMMEND APPROVAL OF IMPLEMENTATION PLAN FOR HB20-1002 (A PLAN TO AWARD TRANSFERRABLE COLLEGE CREDIT FOR WORK-RELATED EXPERIENCE) AND APPROVAL OF REVISIONS TO CCHE POLICY SECTION I, PART X: PRIOR LEARNING ASSESSMENT

The Council reviewed materials for the Commission, which included revisions to the CCHE Prior Learning Assessment Policy, the implementation plan developed by GE Council, and a cover memo that explained the process followed and the actions recommended. Minor changes were recommended and will be incorporated into the materials that are presented to the Commission at its December 2 meeting.

2. SHEEO Transfer Policy Project update

The project leadership team met at the end of October, after which a decision was made to contract with the Denver Education Attainment Network to administer the required survey to transfer students on campuses around the state. The project leadership team will also assemble 3-4 committees aligned with the different transfer dimensions and look for co-chairs from among the leadership group. Questions/issues raised:

- What is the timeline for administration of the survey and when will the CDHE team receive the data?
- How do we build/advance an assessment culture around transfer?
- We might approach this project as laying the groundwork for a future initiative and future set of research questions.
- It was suggested that we might pause the project until the 1330 task force report is delivered, or we have a better understanding of how the recommendations will be addressed/pursued.
- We might consider the process by which individual institutions award credit, but not necessarily credit approved for statewide transfer.

3. Google Certificates exploration update

A team comprised primarily of reps from CDHE and from CU Boulder is discussing the agenda for a convening in mid-February that will be focused on the potential integration of Google Certifications into curricular pathways, potentially as credit-bearing experiences (aligned with HB20-1002) or as enhancements that improve student skills and employability.

4. Winter/Spring Fac2Fac - agenda items?

The council discussed potential topics for discussion at the Spring Fac2Fac, scheduled for February 18. The agenda could include review of industry certs or other credential learning for potential statewide transfer (per HB20-1002), review of the IB math curriculum, and other items.
