Christina and Chris provided updates on meetings of statewide discipline groups and the status of discussion on their STAAs. The discussions are a continuation of the “Revisit, Revise, Refresh” process that started in Fall 2019 and was paused during COVID.

2. CCCS 4-digit conversion to GTP database/STAAs

- a. Danen Jobe informed Council members that the new 4-digit course numbers for CCCS will go live for the Summer 2022 term. Students will begin registering for classes in the coming weeks. This led to a discussion about how to update the STAA documents. It was suggested that DHE staff update the documents with both the original 3-digit and new 4-digit course numbers together.
