Colorado Application For State Financial Aid

I am not a U.S. citizen

- I qualify as a Colorado ASSET student because:
 - I have attended a Colorado high school for at least one year immediately before graduation or completed a high school equivalency examination in Colorado
 - I have had a continuous and physical presence in Colorado for 12 months before the start of the semester
- I should complete a CASFA if I have financial need, regardless of my Colorado ASSET eligibility

FAFSA

Free Application For Federal Student Aid

I am a U.S. citizen or I am an "eligible noncitizen" because (1 of 6 needed):

- I am a U.S. permanent resident and I have a Permanent Resident Card (I-151 or I-551)
- I have an I-94 that indicates:
 - Refugee
 - Asylum Granted
 - Conditional Resident Alien
 - Cuban-Haitian Entrant
- Conditional Entrant (valid only if issued before April 1, 1980)
- Parolee (provide evidence from USCIS)
- Modified parole requirements for Ukrainians and Afghans paroled into the U.S. under certain time frames
- I have a T-visa for victims of human trafficking
- I qualify under the Violence Against Women Act (VAWA)
